This leaflet provides information on the current state and the development of agriculture in the service area of the AELF Kempten.

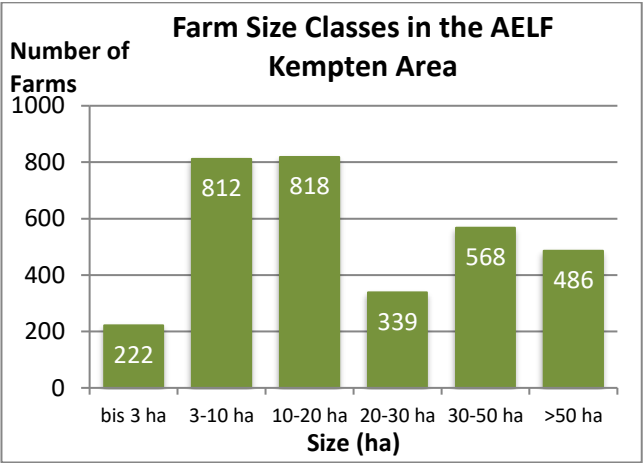
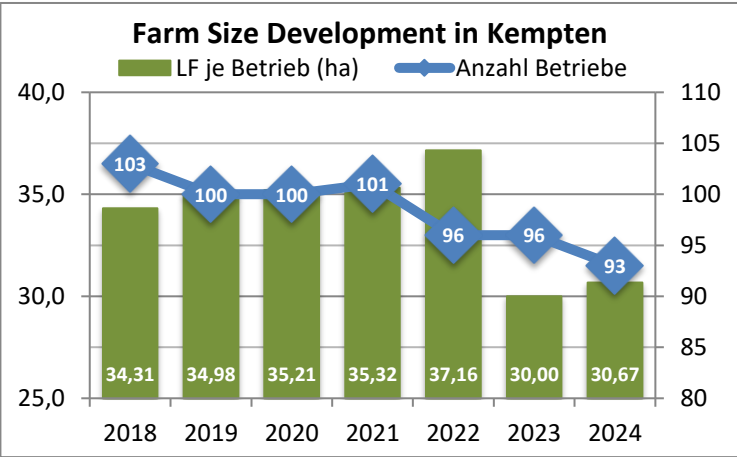
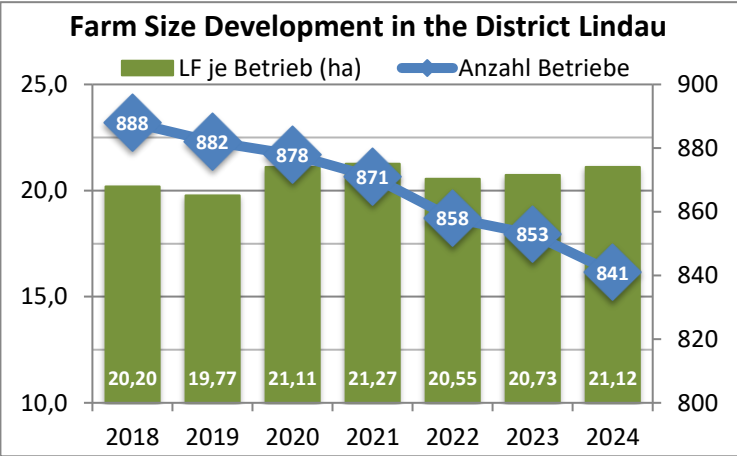
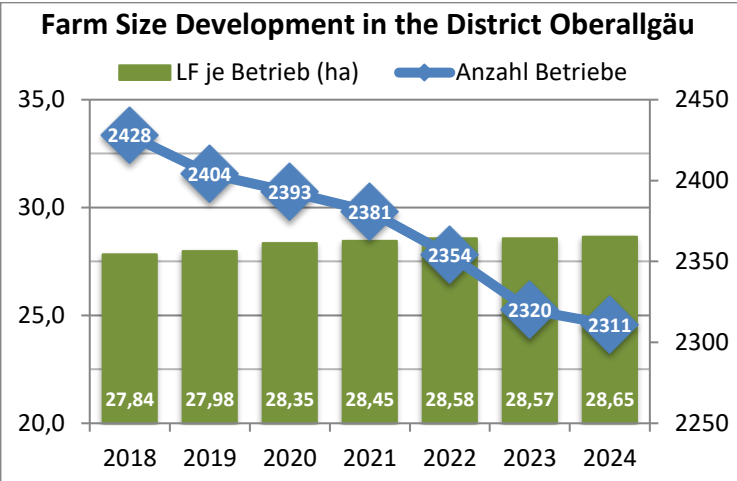
The figures, derived from multiple applications in recent years, give an overview of the different farm structures in the region. Dairy farming, as the most important production sector, is given special attention.
